In song, dance and spoken word, we explore the power and potential that comes with Resurrection. We follow Inanna as she descends into the Underworld of her sister Erishkigal, her shadow-self. This ancient myth is filled with powerful symbolism of the shadow. The shadow is not to be ignored or conquered but must be embraced and integrated into the conscious ego. The work of meeting and embracing the shadow is a divine dance of integration. Yet integration requires the ultimate sacrifice, death. The old self, as we've always known it to be, must die so that a new self can be reborn.



We celebrate Inanna's resurrection, the blessed rebirth of the Earth, and our own divine renewal. Like Inanna, we die, are reborn, and rise again . . . to share with the world what we learned when we were underground.
